What is the CEPII?

French research center in international economics, the CEPII produces studies, researches, databases and analyses on the world economy and its evolution. Founded in 1978, the CEPII is affiliated with the Centre d'analyse stratégique.

How to access the CEPII 's works?

Through working papers and publications: La Lettre du CEPII (monthly), *The CEPII Newsletter* (quarterly), *L'économie mondiale* (yearly), international academic journals.

Who is the CEPII's work aimed at ?

Private and public decision-makers, international institutions, economists, civil society, press.

How does the CEPII conduct his work?

With databases, models, expertise and international cooperation. The CEPII is organized around five research programs, each led by a scientific supervisor.

And for firms?

The CEPII Business Club regularly organises conferences especially aimed at firms, relying on the CEPII's expertise and its research networks.

What are its research areas ?

Competitiveness, specialization, outsourcing, trade negotiations, trade in services, foreign direct investment, large emerging economies, European integration, tax competition, financial globalization, exchange rates, migrations...

How is an independant judgment guaranteed ?

The only criteria for publication are pertinence and scientific quality. This principle is applied under the supervision of the Scientific Committee. The committee is currently chaired by Francesco Giavazzi, Professor at Bocconi University in Milan and at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

Who sets the CEPII's work program?

The CEPII's board, which gathers twice a year leading executives from governmental bodies as well as independent experts. The board also reviews the annual report.



THE CEPII's DATABASES

BACI

World Database of International Trade at the Product Level providing reconciled values, quantities and unit values for about 5000 products, over 200 countries, from 1994. Built with COMTRADE. Available on line for COMTRADE members

BASELINE

is the database developed by the CEPII in 2010 to picture THE WORLD ECONOMY IN 2050. Available on line.

CHELEM

Three harmonized world databases (trade, GDP and balances of payments), starting in 1967. Available on line and on CD-ROM.

Distances

Geographic data for estimation of gravity equations. Wide geographic cover. Available on line.

Export Sophistication

EXPY indexes 1997-2007. Measures of product-level sophistication PRODY (1997). Accessible en ligne.

FDI

Harmonized bilateral flows and stocks of FDI for 26 sectors, in 2004: 96 countries of the GTAP 6.2 database for stocks and 70 countries for flows. Available on line.

Gravity Dataset

"Square" gravity dataset for all world pairs of countries, for the period 1948 to 2006. Available on line.

MACMAP-HS6

Exhaustive Database of customs tariffs applied bilaterally, taking into account preferential rates and regional agreements. Database built from ITC (UNCTAD-WTO) data. Detailed data available on WITS (WB) web site. Aggregated data available on CEPII web site. Data used in GTAP6.

Trade Unit Values

Data for relative productivity levels (1997). Indexes of evolution and exchange rates (1980-2001) for a few countries. Available on line.

Market Potentials

Provides 6 distinct indices of proximity to world markets for more than 150 countries and 44 years. Available on line.

Historical series for France. Available on line.
